AN EXCITING OPPORTUNITY AT THE OLSRUD FAMILY COMMUNITY PLAYGROUND AT BEAR CREEK PARK

For more than three decades the custom-built, castle-like playground structure at Bear Creek Park has stood as southern Oregon's most unique and best-loved playground, a hub of adventure play for children from all over the Rogue Valley. It was constructed as a result of a broad community partnership and collaboration that promoted unity, inclusion, collaboration and volunteerism. The existing wooden structure has reached the end of its useful lifecycle and time has come to replace the playground to meet the needs of future generations.

In keeping with the spirit of the original 1980s process, the Medford Parks and Recreation Department reached out to nearby Roosevelt and Hoover Elementary Schools students who provided their vision and ideas on what a new playground should look like. A community survey also underscored the need for a more accessible playground with improved access for children of all abilities.
